#### 7.0 Old Business

- **7.1 Fashion Show Report** -Darlene Y. reported the tentative date for the 2016 fashion show is May 4. Proceeds from the fashion show are relatively the same as last year. \$ 9397 in 2014 and \$10,644 this year with a few remaining small bills outstanding. She had a question about insurance for outreach activities. Sandy and Gloria H. will check with Guild Insurance.
- **7.2 Composite Paddles** Gloria P., Sandra, Evelyn and Annette met to discuss the purchasing and type of composite paddles for the team. Price varies from \$134 USD to \$300 USD plus. We would look at pricing out the paddles we wanted and then see if Stream N' Wood can order in or get a comparable paddle at a comparable price. Wilderness Supply in Winnipeg is another supplier.

Gloria has secured \$2800.00 in sponsorship from two construction companies. One company has provided a cheque for \$2000.00 for the team and the second company will cover the purchase price of four paddles, one for Gloria, one for Sandra, and two friend's of Gloria's. Gloria is also investigating further sponsorship with the assistance of Dauphin Clinic Pharmacy. This funding has been put on hold till we know the exact number of paddles we need.

We have team approval to order 12 paddles Grey Owl Carbon Jet from Wilderness Supply in Winnipeg.
