6.1 Policy/Guidelines

6.2 Festivals and Demonstrations

6.2.1 Saskatoon, July 24, 25 and 26

Kathy Cameron has checked on 6 hotels; 2 hotels rooms are all booked. The Radisson is across the bridge and they have 12 rooms with 1 Queen bed and 1 double pullout for \$129... For a 15 minute drive, there is the Comfort Inn which is across town. They have 4 rooms with a Queen bed for \$110 and 8 suites with a King bed/Livingroom with a hideaway at \$120. They have a free breakfast but no pool. After some discussion, it was decided that we would book into the Radisson Hotel. Kathy also checked out 3 bus lines; two were from Brandon with an identical price. Brandon Bus lines have really good reviews and Prairie Coach has so-so reviews. The cost is \$2,625. to include a 47 passenger Coach with bathroom, paid hotel room for the driver and a 25% deposit is needed to confirm. We have budgeted for the bus but the cost exceeds the budget quote; we will need to go to the team to cover the extra costs which we can do at a practice. The early out-of-town registration is \$750.00 which saves us \$100. this includes free entry to the Rotary Village and the Friday night challenge.

6.2.2 Demos

Nothing is organized as yet. Kathy has Sandy Lake in mind. Merle mentioned Neepawa during their Lily Festival on Lake Irwin. This is usually near the end of July.

6.2.3 Peterborough

The cost for this festival is \$280. a person which includes a \$5.00 IBCPC levy. The cost includes on water practices to include transport; opening and closing ceremonies; Saturday gala dinner; bbq hosted by the Mayor; individual ID tags; souvenir bag; souvenir program; lunch on both race days; bottled water at the site; transport from official recommended accommodations to race site, opening/closing ceremonies, practices and Saturday night gala plus other commemorative event items. We can bring this up at the Spring Team meeting.

6.3 Captain/Coach

The Sportsplex availability expects to be there until 2013. There is no immediate concern

6.4 Boat and Equipment

6.4.1 Transportation of Boat while Kingdons away

As Ron and Gaileen will be away touring the "North", leaving on May 17th arrangements have been made with Jake N. to bring the boat to practices once we get on Lake Minnedosa. It will remain in storage in the shed at the Kingdons' place and Jake will pick it up from there. As we had a good clean up session at the end of last year, Ron feels the boat will not need painting or varnishing at this time; they will reassess this fall. Ron will have the wheel bearings on the trailer done before they leave on holidays.

6.4.2 Retrieving Life Jackets

Betty has been in touch with Shelley and she will send her life jacket with Marilyn when she is coming to practice. At this point I told her to keep the life jacket until Marilyn is better. The other life jacket is with Dawn Williams and I will contact her again after the Fashion Show. Gaileen has Sharon's life jacket and I have her paddle. The paddles that are being donated by

the Kiwanis Club of Brandon have been ordered and Warren at Stream and Wood will contact us when they arrive.

6.4.3 Tarp

Ron took the tarp in to Glen Mattice in Nov. He checked on Thurs. and it was still in the same place. However Glen will check it and probably replace the bungee cords. This will result in less expense than originally expected.

6.4.4 Tent

As we would have to pay extra to bring a tent to Winnipeg, the only time we would use this tent is once in Brandon. We need to get costs and how easy the tent would be to put up; TABLED to next meeting.

Diane Harrington and Joyce Johnson will look after lunches for our Minnedosa practices. At functions where we need food we can perhaps look at getting it catered. We have a smaller group this year and we are all busy. We would access the need for food on the type of social get together on a case by case.

6.10.3 WCDBR Fundraiser

The date has been set for September 19th and the contract has been signed today. Gail Bordian is Chair and will get lots of help from her daughter, Dawn Meek.
